



SMART & SKILLED SUBSIDIES

Smart & Skilled subsidies are now available for many of our courses.

A description of subsidies available appears below. Please call the College to discuss your eligibility and determine your fee.

Subsidies are available to any person that:

- · Works or lives in NSW, and
- Is an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen, and
- Is no longer at school, is aged 15 years or older, or is a registered home schooled student.

Fee Exemptions are available for:

- Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- Students who receive a disability support pension including the dependent child, spouse or partner of a recipient of a disability support pension
- Students studying qualifications under the Entitlement Foundations Skills program
- Refugees and asylum seekers
- Recipients of Fee-Free Scholarships

Fee exemption criteria must be met and fees will be discussed with you at the time of enrolment.

Fee Free Scholarships are available if you:

- meet the Smart & Skilled eligibility criteria and are receiving a prescribed government benefit; and
- are aged 15-17 and living in out-of-home care; or
- are aged 18-30 and previously in out-ofhome care; or
- are aged 15 and over and have experienced domestic and family violence.

Scholarships may be limited. More information is available at: www.smartandskilled.nsw.gov.au Fee Concessions apply if you receive a prescribed government benefit; you may only need to pay a concession fee of between \$16O-\$24O.
