RECOGNISED TRAINING

The Nationally Recognised Training (NRT) logo identifies national vocational education and training which leads to Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) qualifications or Statements of Attainment.

SMART & SKILLED SUBSIDIES

Smart & Skilled subsidies are now available for many of our courses.

A description of subsidies available appears below. Please call the College to discuss your eligibility and determine your fee.

Subsidies are available to any person that:

- Works or lives in NSW, and
- Is an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand citizen, and
- Is no longer at school, is aged 15 years or older, or is a registered home schooled student.

Fee Exemptions are available for:

- Australian Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- Students who receive a disability support pension including the dependent child, spouse or partner of a recipient of a disability support pension
- Students studying qualifications under the Entitlement Foundations Skills program
- Refugees and asylum seekers
- Recipients of Fee-Free Scholarships

Fee exemption criteria must be met and fees will be discussed with you at the time of enrolment.

Fee Free Scholarships are available if you:

- meet the Smart & Skilled eligibility criteria and are receiving a prescribed government benefit; and
- are aged 15-17 and living in out-of-home care; or
- are aged 18-30 and previously in out-of-home care; or
- are aged 15 and over and have experienced domestic and family violence.

Scholarships may be limited.

Fee Concessions apply if you receive a prescribed government benefit; you may only need to pay a concession fee of between \$160-\$240.

The concession Includes a dependent child, spouse or partner of a recipient of a prescribed government benefit.

Second qualifications

Your fee may be slightly higher for a second qualification.

Smart & Skilled is a funding initiative of the NSW Government. Please call the College to discuss your eligibility and determine your fee.

SKILLING FOR FEE-FREE TRAINING IN NSW

You may be eligible for a fee-waiver. To find out more about eligibility criteria and the courses that applies to, please visit our website or contact the college.

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Some of our courses have entry requirements. You will be eligible to enrol in a course if you meet these entry requirements.

Entry requirements are the minimum knowledge, skills, experience, qualifications and attributes you need to successfully complete the course.

Not all courses have entry requirements, but some have very specific mandatory conditions before you can enrol. You must be able to show that you meet the entry requirements to be able to enrol in the course.

The entry requirements for each course will be clearly displayed in the course information located on our website or in specific course flyers.

We encourage all prospective students to ring for a chat, to find out more information about the course you wish to study and to determine if there are applicable entry requirements.
